As funding for the IPSP is indexed each financial year in line with any increase in the Commonwealth annual budget appropriation, the actual maximum funding available in 2013 will be increased by the rate of indexation for the period 1 July – 31 December 2013.
    - The allocation for Flexible Support Funding will be advised to successful applicants in the Letter of Offer.
  - **Early childhood education and care services in the Region**

  - **Children in IPSP priority groups in the Region**
    - The number of children from IPSP priority groups enrolled in Child Care Benefit approved services based on DEEWR's *Early Childhood Education & Care Workforce Census*, May 2010.
