DESCRIPTION

 - The allocation for Flexible Support Funding will be advised to successful applicants in the Letter of Offer.

 - The number of eligible Child Care Benefit approved services based on DEEWR's Child Care Management System administrative data, December Quarter 2010 (the latest quarter for which data are available).
 - The number of eligible non Child Care Benefit approved services (may include Indigenous focused Budget Based Funded services) current as at December 2010 and based on DEEWR administrative data.
 - **Children in IPSP priority groups in the Region**
 - The number of children from IPSP priority groups enrolled in Child Care Benefit approved services based on DEEWR's *Early Childhood Education & Care Workforce Census*, May 2010.
