DESCRIPTION

As funding for the IPSP is indexed each financial year in line with any increase in the Commonwealth annual budget appropriation, the actual maximum funding available in 2013 will be the amount shown increased by the rate of indexation for the period 1 July to 31 December 2013.
 - The allocation for Flexible Support Funding will be advised to successful applicants in the Letter of Offer.
