DESCRIPTION

 - The funding amount shown is the indicative funding available for 1 January to 31 December 2013. This period spans two financial years. As funding for the IPSP is indexed each financial year in line with any increase in the Commonwealth annual budget appropriation, the actual maximum funding available in 2013 will be the amount shown increased by the rate of indexation for the period 1 July to 31 December 2013.
 - The allocation for Flexible Support Funding will be advised to successful applicants in the Letter of Offer.
 - **Early childhood education and care services in the Region**
 - The number of eligible Child Care Benefit approved services based on DEEWR's Child Care Management System administrative data, December Quarter 2010 (the latest quarter for which data are available).
 - The number of eligible non Child Care Benefit approved services (may include Indigenous focused Budget Based Funded services) current as at December 2010 and based on DEEWR administrative data.
 - **Children in IPSP priority groups in the Region**
