DESCRIPTION

This Region Profile contains information relevant to Applicants submitting an application for funding as the National Inclusion Support Subsidy Provider, under the Inclusion and Professional Support Program (IPSP).

The Region for the National Inclusion Support Subsidy Provider (NISSP) is the whole of Australia. The NISSP Region Profile for Australia includes:

1. Funding for the Region

The funding amount shown is the indicative funding available for 1 January to 31 December 2013. This period spans two financial years. As funding for the IPSP is indexed each financial year in line with any increase in the Commonwealth annual budget appropriation, the actual maximum funding available in 2013 will be the amount shown increased by the rate of indexation for the period 1 July – 31 December 2013.

2. Number of eligible Child Care Benefit Approved child care services based on DEEWR's Child Care Management System, December quarter 2010 (the latest quarter for which data are available).
3. Approximate number of Inclusion Support Subsidy (ISS) applications processed annually based on quarterly reports from the current NISSP provider in the 2010-2011 financial year.
4. Approximate number of eligible services approved to receive ISS funding based on quarterly reports from the current NISSP provider for the period 1 January 2011 to 30 June 2011.
5. Indicative total amount of Inclusion Support Subsidy Program funding available for the ISS for 1 January to 31 December 2013.
