NATIONAL GREEN JOBS CORPS is an Australian Government initiative that provides accredited training and work experience opportunities in the developing green skills and climate change industries.

ELIGIBILITY

If you are an Australian citizen or permanent resident aged between 17—24 years, not working more than 15 hours per week, or in full time education, National Green Jobs Corps may be just what you are looking for.

PARTICIPANTS

Participants are able to work on projects that make environmental improvements now and develop green skills for the future.

As a participant in National Green Jobs Corps you will:

- develop green skills
- achieve a nationally recognised qualification
- make new friends and learn work skills
- get hands-on experience in applying the skills you learn, and
- gain a sense of satisfaction by contributing to important community projects.

Best of all, National Green Jobs Corps will give you a solid platform to get work with employers recognising the valuable skills and experience that you gained through participating in National Green Jobs Corps.

National Green Jobs Corps projects will run for 26 weeks with participants spending an average of 25 hours per week doing hands-on work experience activities and accredited training. Time spent participating in National Green Jobs Corps projects will have long term value when you consider the benefits that these projects will provide to your self development and the community.

If you are receiving Centrelink payments such as Newstart Allowance, Youth Allowance (other) or Parenting Payment you will be able to meet your requirements by participating in National Green Jobs Corps. In addition, you may be eligible to receive a National Green Jobs Corps Supplement of \$41.60 per fortnight.

If you are 24 years old and participating in NGJC you will not continue to receive the supplement once you turn 25.
