  - (b) have a first language that is not English and have been assessed as requiring **intensive** instruction in English as a Second Language;
  - (c) have not previously been granted financial assistance under the ESL-NA Program, either in this year or in previous years;
  - (d) have enrolled in an **intensive** English language course funded under this program:
    - (i) if entering the first year of primary schooling to have enrolled within **18** months of arrival in Australia; or
    - (ii) if entering all other years of schooling, within **six** months of arrival in Australia.
  - (e) at the time of enrolling in the initial intensive English language course, are undertaking, or have an intention to undertake, either before or as soon as practicable after completion of the course, primary or secondary education at a non-government school.

  - (d) have enrolled in an **intensive** English language course funded under this program:
    - (i) if entering the first year of primary schooling to have enrolled within **18** months of arrival in Australia or of being granted a temporary visa under the Humanitarian Program; or
    - (ii) if entering all other years of schooling, within **six** months of arrival in Australia or of being granted a temporary visa under the Humanitarian Program.
  - (e) at the time of enrolling in the initial intensive English language course, are undertaking, or have an intention to undertake, either before or as soon as practicable after completion of the course, primary or secondary education at a non-government school.
